

Public Health Emergency Preparedness Grant (PHEP) Deliverables Grant Year 2010 (August 10, 2009 – August 9, 2010) (v2)

- **All Hazards Planning – August 9, 2010**
 - 90% with All Hazard Response Plan (CEMP)
 - 100% of local public health agencies have Continuity of Operations (COOP) Plan
- **Emergency Dispensing Sites (EDS) Plans**
 - 100% of communities have updated EDS Plan in place – July 19, 2010
 - 100% of communities will conduct EDS staff call down drill (using CDC metric) – February, 2010
 - 100% of communities will conduct EDS site notification drill (using CDC metric) – March 31, 2010
 - One or more exercises to test portion of EDS plan via tabletop or additional drill (CDC Metric) – August 9, 2010
 - 100% of EDS Plans will complete a Technical Assessment Review (TAR) – July 19, 2010
 - Based on TAR, 100% will identify one or more gaps & develop an improvement plan – July 19, 2010
- **Communications**
 - Update 24/7/365 contact list quarterly
 - Conduct 24/7/365 contact list drill (DPH provided metric) – August 9, 2010
 - Two or more HHAN drills (DPH metric) – August 9, 2010
- **Trainings**
 - All BOH members or staff with a management role in a public health response have completed ICS 100, ICS 200, and NIMS 700, as well as ICS 300 & 400 as needed. – December, 2009
- **Mutual Aid**
 - Submit strategy and timeline to implement Mutual Aid agreements – June 30, 2010
 - Submit statement when completed for coalition
- **Multi-Year Exercise Plan**
 - Submit updated multi-year Exercise Plan to include exercises required in deliverables – December 31, 2010
- **Coalition Operating Procedures**
 - Review, update & approve Principles of Operation for coalition – June 10, 2010
